- ◆ Welcome to Fort Collins (“FoCo”) – thanks for coming!
- ◆ Some facts about Fort Collins and CSU:
 - Population of Fort Collins: ~170k
 - Elevation: ~1 mile above sea level (similar to Denver)
 - Roughly *20 breweries* in Fort Collins
 - CSU established in 1870 as land-grant university
 - Students: ~26k undergrads, ~7k postgrads
 - CSU has business school and vet school, but no med school
- ◆ CSU Physics Department facts:
 - Roughly 20 faculty members, 60 graduate students
 - Mainly HEPPA (HEP and Particle Astrophysics), CM (Condensed Matter), AMO experiment; also a few theorists
 - CSU HEPPA group founded in 1992 by Walter Toki

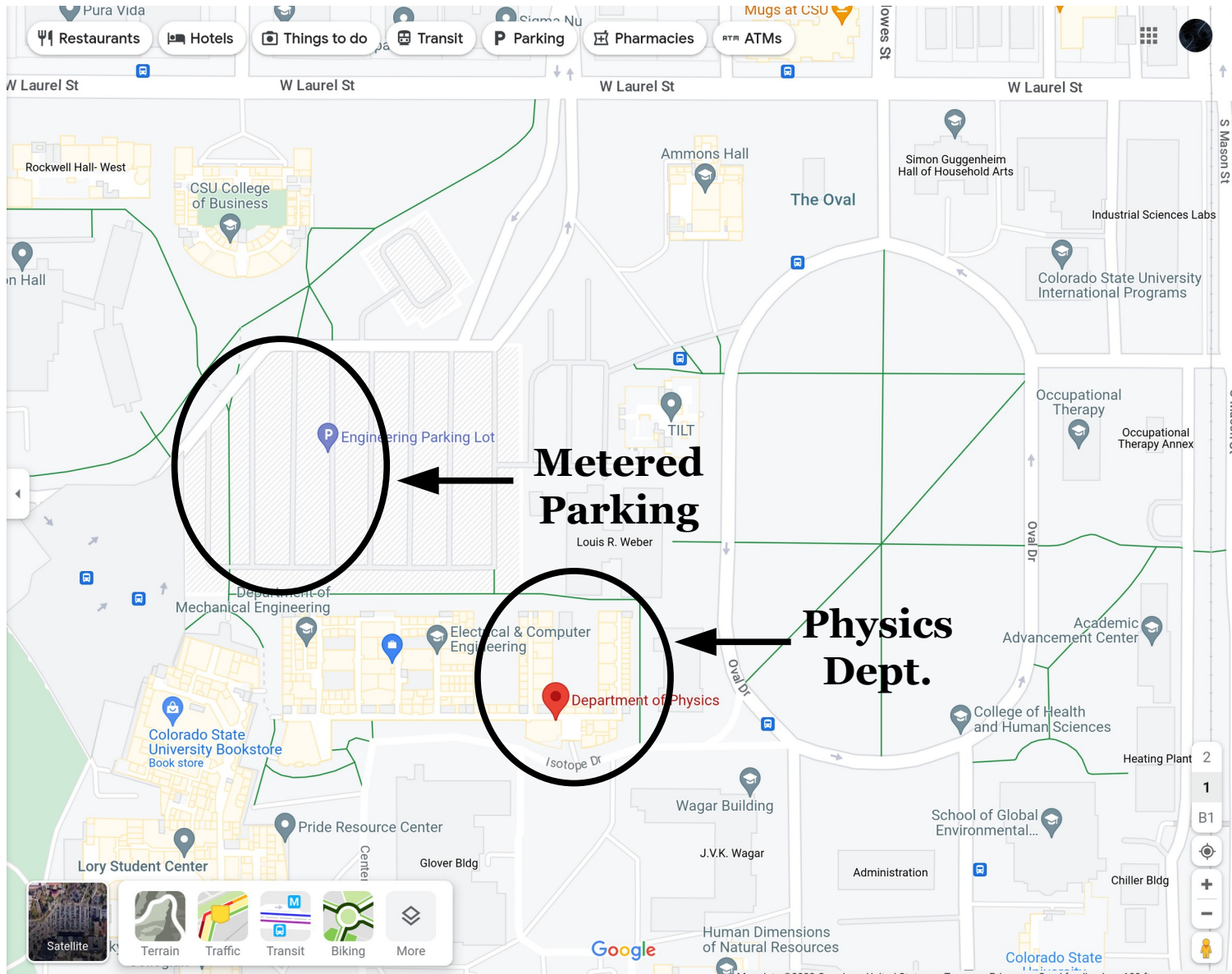
