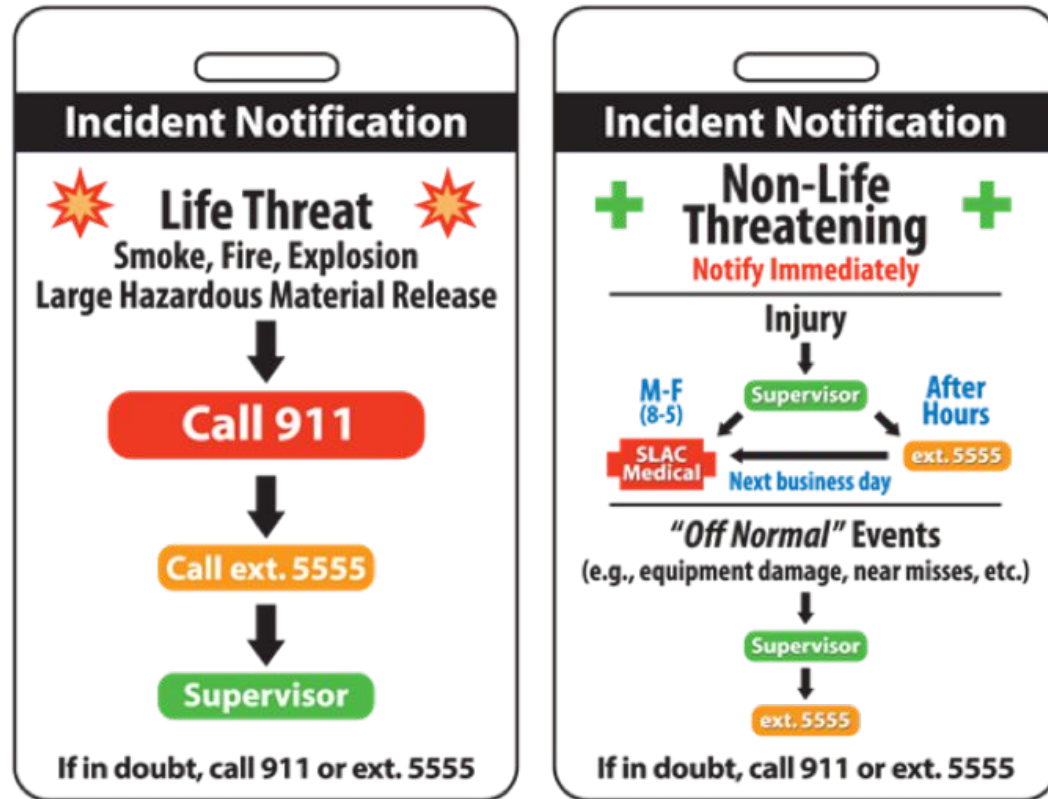

Safety First!



In case of an emergency

Fire

- Evacuate. Be aware of building exits
- Follow building residents to the assembly area
- Do not leave until you are accounted for, and have been instructed to leave.

Earthquake

- Remain in building: Duck, cover, and hold position
- When shaking stops: Evacuate building via a safe route to the assembly area
- Do not leave until you are accounted for, and have been instructed to leave.

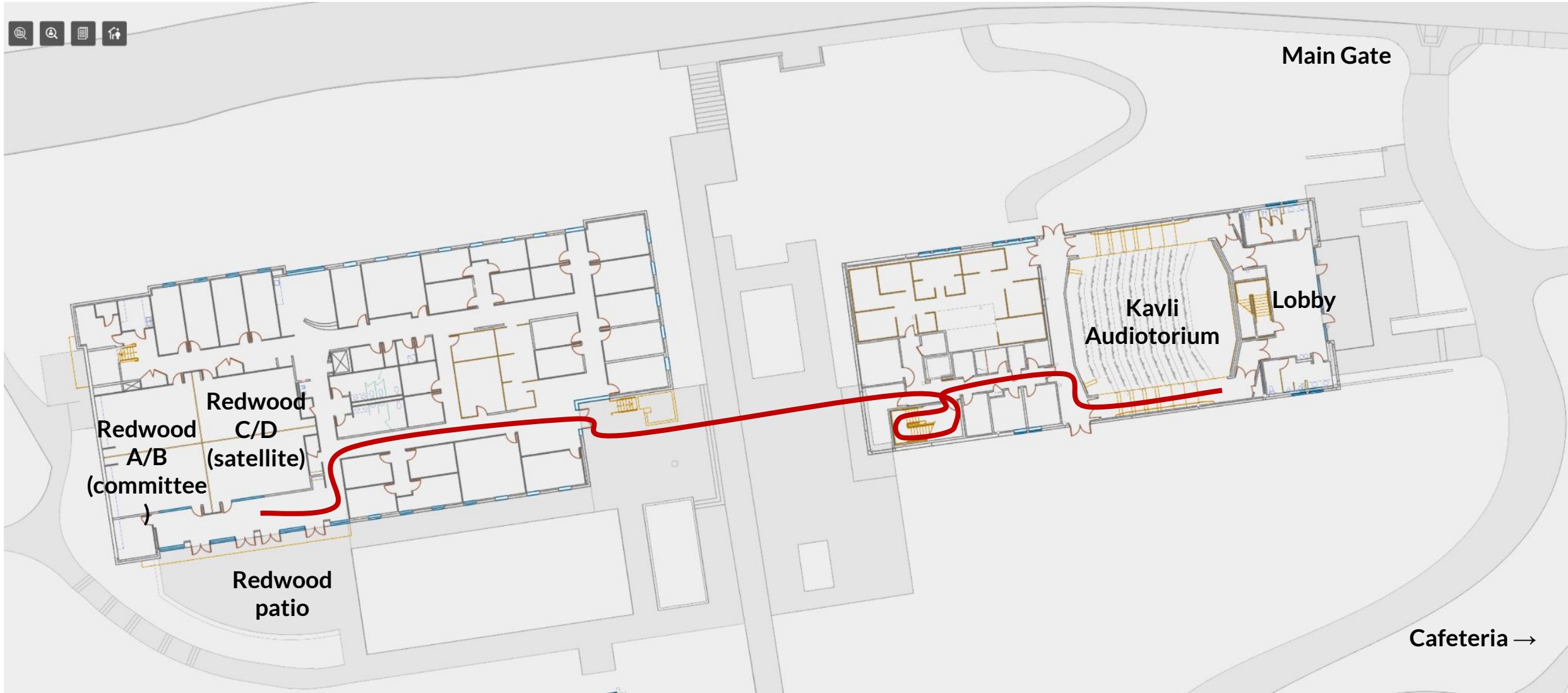
Venue
